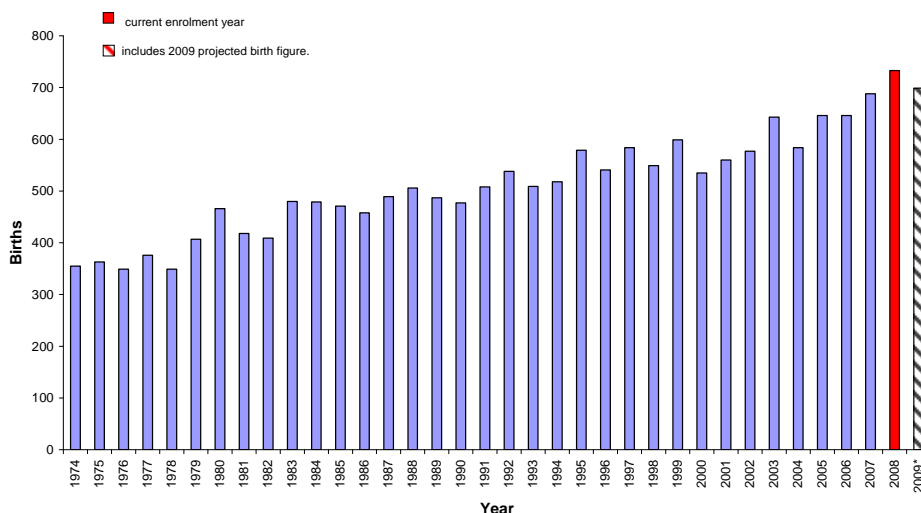

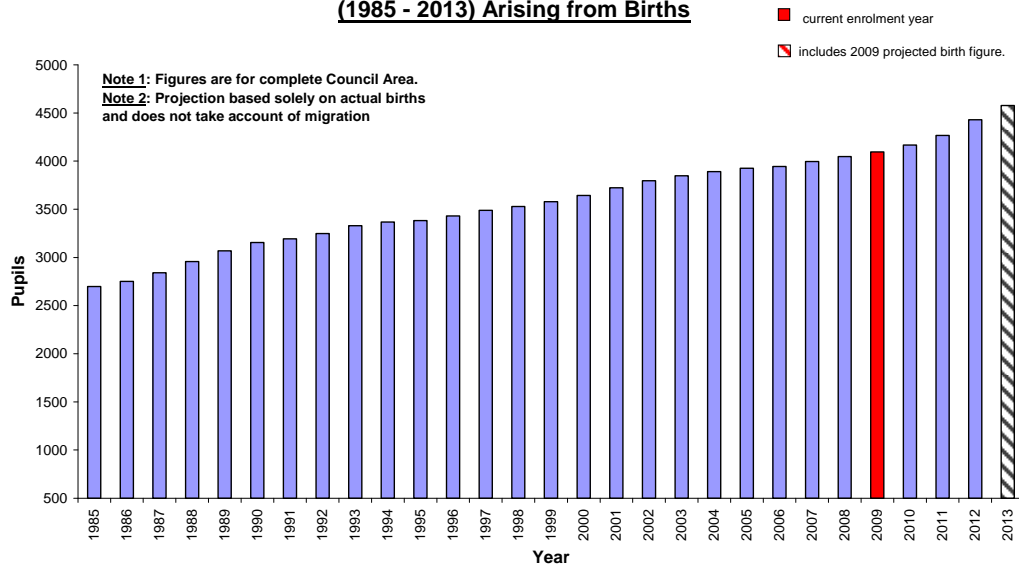

(1985 - 2013) Arising from Births



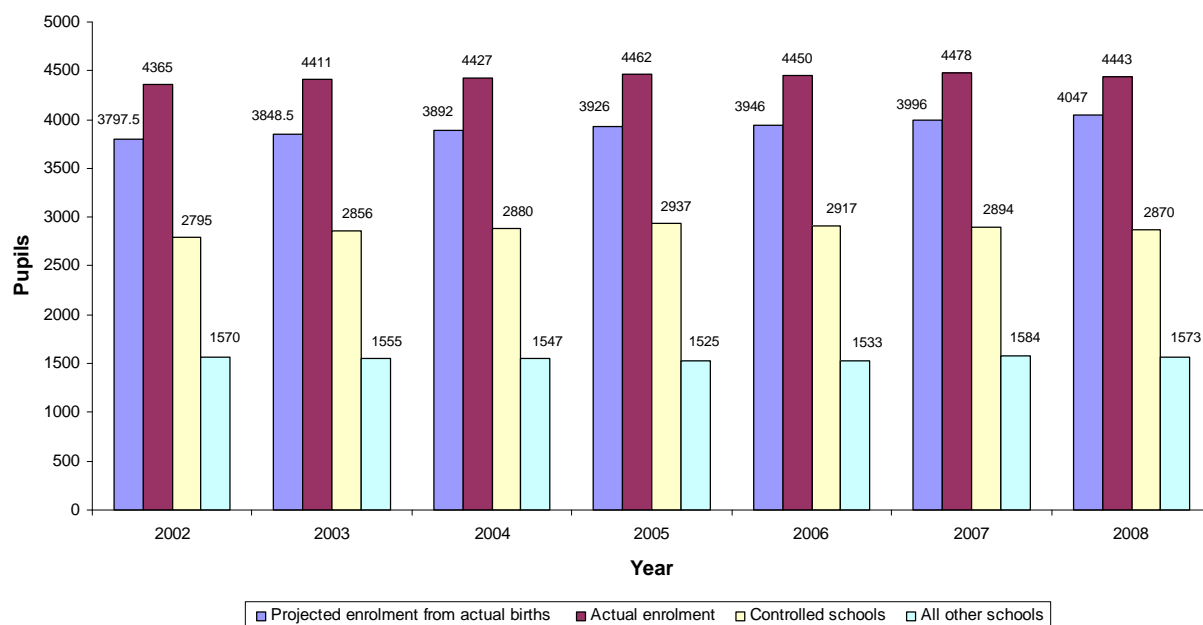

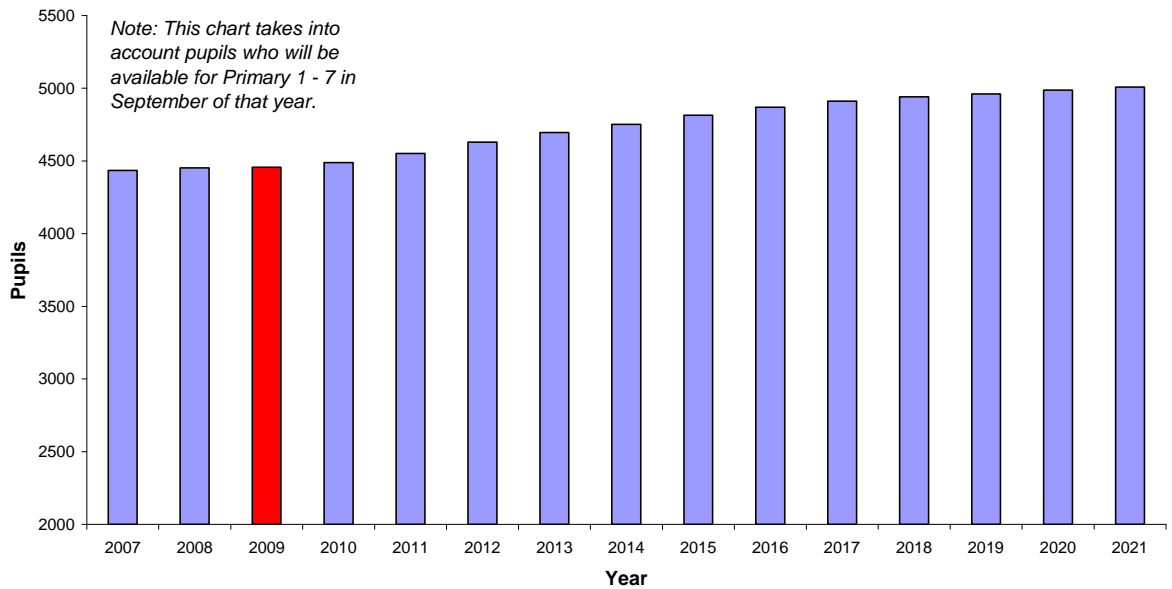
