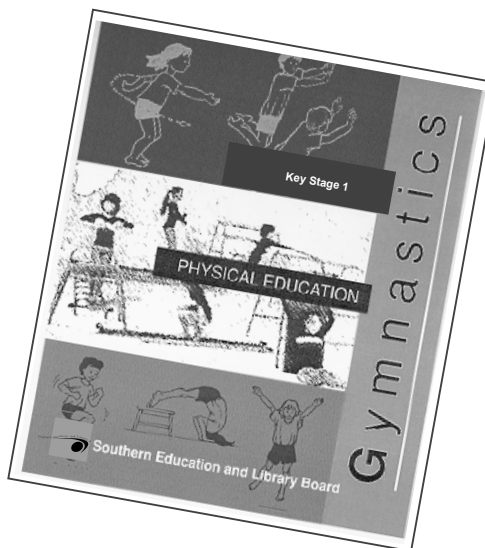

This is a one day course targeted at primary 3 - 7 teachers who wish to provide enjoyable and challenging dance experiences for all pupils in line with the requirements of the NI curriculum. The course will involve a blend of discussion and practical workshops which will examine best practice in developing a selection of simple folk dances. The course will include a review of the requirements of the programme of study, the teaching and learning issues relevant to the key skills in dance and class organisation.

As a result of participation in this course teachers will:

- be more confident and creative in teaching the dance element of the programme of study for primary physical education.
- have experienced a range of appropriate teaching and learning activities for developing simple folk dances in the primary school.
- practise the appropriate and inclusive teaching and learning approaches for key dance skills.
- have explored the use of different stimuli and appropriate music for dance.

- have reviewed relevant resources, health and safety issues and planning methods for gymnastics - including safe handling of apparatus.
