The Royal Society is delighted to invite nominations for the Hauksbee Awards; a new set of awards developed to recognise the unsung heroes of science, technology, engineering and mathematics, as part of the Royal Society's 350th Anniversary celebrations.

The Hauksbee Awards have been created to recognise and reward individuals who excel in their roles supporting the UK science base, such as **school science technicians, teachers and teaching assistants**. The awards are open to any individual working to support science research and education in the UK.

Nominations are invited from senior colleagues and consist of a completed nomination form and a recent CV for the nominee. The winners will receive a Royal Society engraved bronze medal and a £500 gift, presented at an award ceremony in February 2010.
